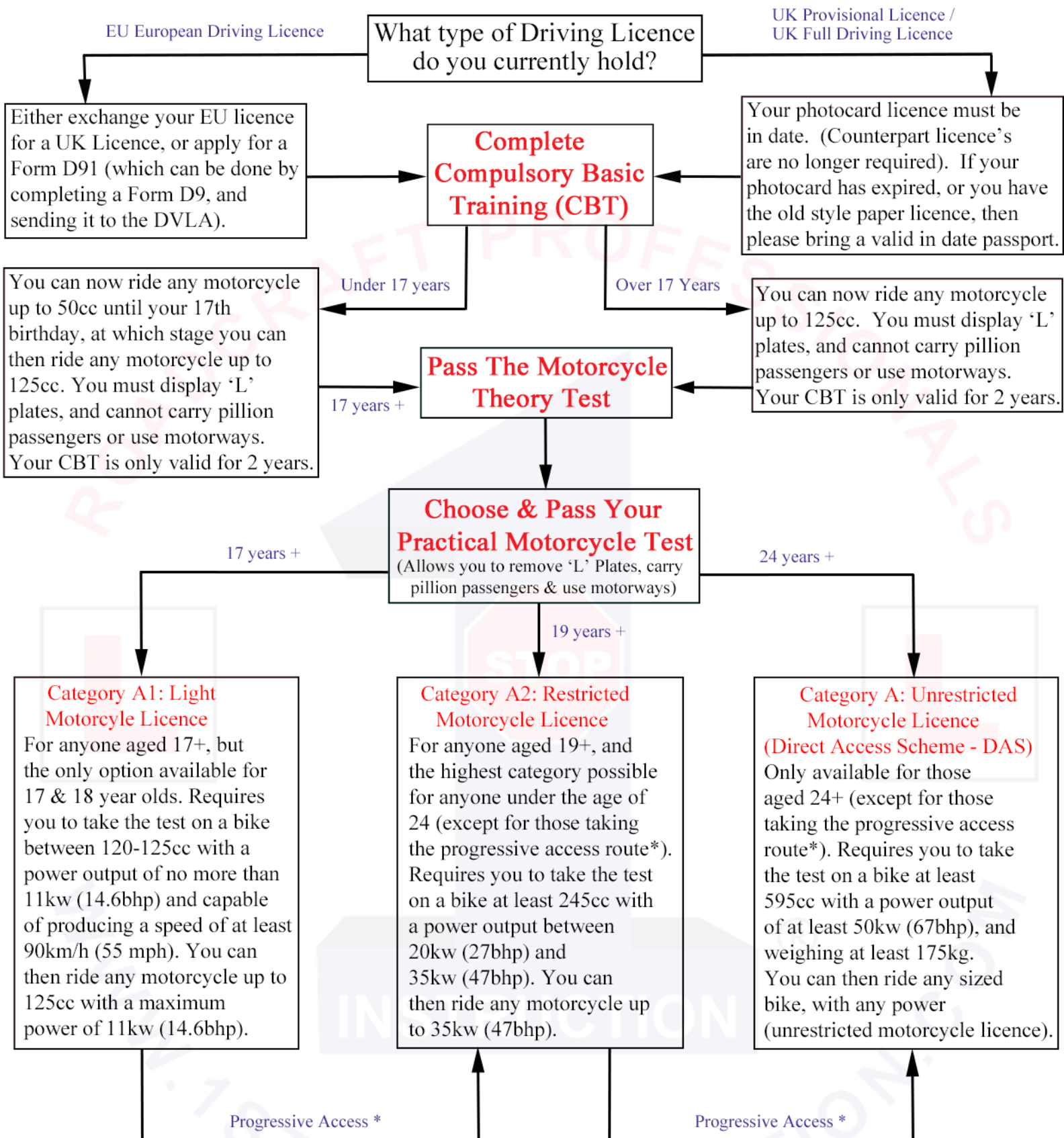


How to get your Motorcycle Licence



*** Progressive Access** – Once you have held a lower category motorcycle licence for a minimum of 2 years, you can upgrade your licence to the next category (with no minimum age or theory test required) by simply re-taking the practical test on a larger sized bike which matches the test criteria for the licence you are upgrading to.

If you reach the minimum age requirement for the next category BEFORE you have held your existing licence for 2 years, or want to 'jump/skip' a category, then you can still upgrade your licence, but you will need to have a valid motorcycle theory certificate (or will need to re-take your theory test again, if the original certificate has expired), since this is NOT following the 'progressive route'. The 'progressive route' only applies to people who have held an existing motorcycle licence for a minimum of 2 years, and are upgrading to the next level of motorcycle category.
